**Spelling**-We will continue to focus on word chunks, word patterns, and word families. This month will be working on the following chunks: ug, all, ack.

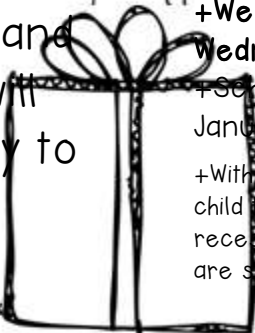


## 7 Habits Principles
